

Project proving popular



BiP SOLUTIONS' Project service is well established as the smartest way to create, manage and transmit contract notices to the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU), but high demand for the service shows that many buyers can still benefit from the features it offers.

Forty more public sector organisations signed up to Project in December 2006, meaning that there are now over 550 such bodies using the service in the UK. Why is Project so popular? The answer is because it helps to take the pressure out of procurement – helping buyers to complete contract notices quickly, accurately and, most importantly, compliantly.

Project enables contracts to be created and managed in a fully secure, managed and audited environment. Notices are validated against the EU Procurement Directives, so reducing the risk of non-compliance, and BiP's expert support team are available to talk users through any issues they may have. Notices sent to the Official Publications Office of the European Union via Project's XML gateway are published in the OJEU within two to three working days, so reducing tendering timescales. However, Project can be used to create contract notices of all values, including those to be published on the **www.supply2.gov.uk** lower-value contracts portal, for which BiP is the service provider.

Project is part of the Delta-ets e-tendering suite of services, which can be used by public sector buyers to handle the full life cycle of the tendering process. Delta-ets includes Select for pre-qualification questionnaires, aXcess for the creation of buyer profiles, Vault for a secure document exchange, and Vault eAuction.
